NEW BUSINESS

- Members were given a comparison of bag count for the months of May and June; there was a 40% improvement in May and a 60% improvement in June.
- Some cottagers have expressed concern with recycling; they would like to see a drop off at the landfill where they could bring their material since they may not always be at the cottage on recycling days.

- Landfill attendant mentioned a problem with one of the bins that was brought to the landfill; it was full of unsorted, unacceptable garbage. Staff to find out from surrounding municipalities how they handle these bins and Mayor Jobin will be asked to speak with the people responsible for this unacceptable garbage.
- Staff will include more information about burning garbage, what to do with bale wrap, and bringing unwanted material to Salvation Army, Rebuilt Resources and or Value Village, and mention By-law (2009-32) that states that no dump on private property.
- Staff to contact farming communities to find out how they handle the bale wrap.
