REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

TUESDAY, APRIL 14TH, 2015

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Leo Jobin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with Councillors David Hodgins, Chris Jull, Walter Ross, and Nunzio Scarfone present. Guests in attendance were Robert Palin, On-Site Sewage Program, North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority, Tim Grimster, Ada Miller, Les Milton, and Marlene and Ron Walton. Dean Decaire, CPA, CA, BDO Canada LLP, joined the meeting in progress as did Shelly Lambe and Nick Lambe Foster. Staff member present was Clerk-Treasurer Linda Ringler.

Robert Palin, Manager, On-Site Sewage Program, North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority, was in attendance to provide information with respect to the *Mandatory Maintenance Inspection Program for Sewage Systems under the Ontario Building Code Act,* and to answer questions in this regard. Mr. Palin provided Council with background, general, and financial information regarding the program.

Dean Decaire, CPA, CA, BDO Canada LLP, was in attendance to present the Financial Statements for the year ended December 31, 2014 to Council, and to answer questions in this regard. Following his presentation, Mr. Decaire left the meeting.

Council considered information with respect to a *Permit to Take Water* issued by the Ministry of Environment for a property located on Chiswick Line, along with an email from the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority outlining the permits required in connection with the *Permit to Take Water*. Concerns expressed by Council members included the potential impact on the Township's road infrastructure and that of a neighbouring municipality, and the amount of water to be taken from the property.

OPEN FORUM

During the Open Forum session, Shelley Lambe brought forward three issues of concern she had with respect to the *Permit to Take Water* issued to a property owner on Chiswick Line, which included a lack of notification and opportunity to provide feedback during the consultation period; a communication breakdown between the Ministry and the Township, and the need for the Township to be aware of items posted on the Environmental Registry; and a need for the Township and residents to assess the impact of the application on the Township's infrastructure and water resources. Ms. Lambe informed Council that it was her intention to write a letter to the Minister of Environment requesting that he temporarily rescind the permit so that a 30-day public consultation can occur and so that the Ministry officials responsible can include the community's feedback in assessing the permit.
