# **PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING**

# **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8<sup>TH</sup>, 2015**

#### CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chair Walter Ross with Mayor Leo Jobin and Councillors David Hodgins, Chris Jull, and Nunzio Scarfone present. Calvin Smith was the only guest in attendance. Jason Leblond joined the meeting in progress. Staff members present were Public Works Supervisor Real Gauthier and Clerk-Treasurer Linda Ringler.

#### **DECLARATION OF PECUNIARY INTEREST**

Councillor Nunzio Scarfone declared a pecuniary interest with respect to the hiring of a second part-time employee, due to his son-in-law's interest in the position, and left the Council Chambers during the discussion regarding this matter.

## **BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES** - None

#### **CITIZEN'S PETITIONS AND DEPUTATIONS**

Calvin Smith, Landfill Contractor, was in attendance to request that the Public Works Committee authorize the removal of a barricade at the field entrance to the Landfill Site to allow him access without having to travel the road to get to the site for his work. After some discussion, the Committee decided to have a gate erected, with a key to be given to Mr. Smith. Mr. Smith was

also asked by Councillor David Hodgins why he was not putting in sufficient cover, and responded that he is, but he will put more if that is what the Committee wants him to do even though it will fill up the site more quickly. It was noted that that the amount of cover material required is 6 inches.

Councillor Scarfone drew the Public Works Supervisor's attention to the bridge on South Shore Road, advising that it looks as if a board has been ripped out at the east left hand corner of the bridge, and requested that an inspection be conducted and repairs be undertaken.

Public Works Chair Walter Ross noted that Public Works is using the snow wing for taking the dirt off the side of the roads, and advised that this is not an acceptable practice, and requested that they cease using it for this purpose.

#### ITEMS FROM PUBLIC WORKS CHAIR WALTER ROSS

<u>Grinding of Material at Landfill</u> – Grinding was completed and the piles are flattened out. Public Works will bring in a dozer and haul fill to cover the top end.

<u>Update on Beaver Dam Removal</u> – Mayor Leo Jobin reported that a lot of trapping has been done, and advised that the dams are lowered a bit each time a time is reset. Councillor David Hodgins informed the Committee that the trapper has advised that he will not be doing any trapping on the creek between the Memorial Park Drive Bridge (#20) and the lake until after freeze up. Staff was asked to contact the trapper and request an invoice, before year end, for the trapping he has done.

<u>Hiring of 2<sup>nd</sup> Part-time Employee</u> – The hiring of a second part-time employer for the 2015 – 2016 winter season was discussed, and the Committee agreed to proceed with this course of action to allow for part-time employees to cover weekend work. A former resolution requiring a full-time employee and a part-time employee to work on weekends will be rescinded as new direction has been given in this regard.
