

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHISHOLM

BY-LAW 2013-14

Being a by-law to amend By-law 2010-06 to provide for the regulation of canines (dogs).

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chisholm enacted By-law 2010-06 on January 26, 2010 to provide for the regulation of canines (dogs);

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to amend certain provisions thereof;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHISHOLM HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 1 of By-law 2012-06 is amended by adding the following definition:
“Herding Dog” shall mean a dog that is actively being used in a bona fide farming operation for the purposes of controlling livestock on the farm.
2. By-law 2012-06 is hereby amended by adding the following clause after Section 3(a):
Notwithstanding Section 3(a), owners may remove the collar and license tag from a livestock guardian dog or herding dog while the dog is being actively used in farming practices, provided that the owner uses an alternative means of identification linking the animal to the name and address of the owner, e.g. either a tattoo or microchip containing the required information.
3. Section 3(s) of By-law 2010-06 is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
This by-law applies to all dogs residing at all residences in the Township, except where exceptions are noted.
4. Schedule “A” to By-law 2010-06 is hereby amended to reflect that the license fee for livestock guardian dogs and herding dogs will be \$10.00 only. There will be no late penalty fee for payment after March 31.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 23rd DAY OF APRIL, 2013.
