## **FREE PLANTS FOR YOUR SHORELINE!** **Restore Your Shore 2019**

If your home, cottage or farmland property boasts a streambank, lakefront, river or watercourse, you may be eligible for free shoreline plants and planting assistance as part of the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority's Restore Your Shore Program. Up to 20 property owners can have their shoreline planted this year with native trees, shrubs and plants to help improve the water quality of our lakes, rivers and streams. Planting of the shoreline will prevent erosion and run off, enhance fish habitat, and reduce the addition of phosphorus into our waterways which contributes to the growth of blue green-algae.
