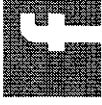

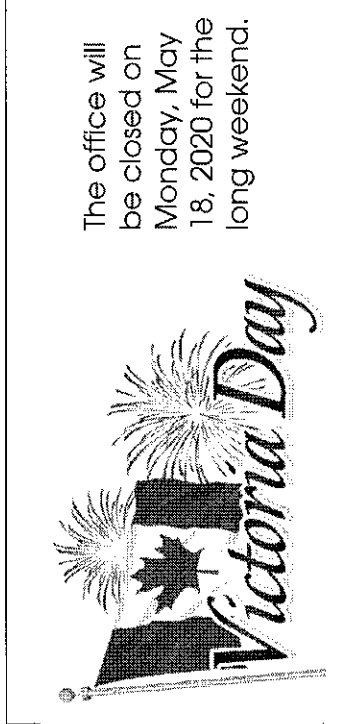

NOTICE - 2020 SPRING LOAD RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT AS OF MARCH 16, 2020

BY-LAW 2019-16

The Township enforces reduced load restrictions on trucks to protect the Township's roadways during spring thaw, when road damage is most likely to occur.

Reduced load limits are in effect where and when signs are posted depending on the road and weather conditions.
