

**TOWNSHIP OF CHISHOLM**  
**PUBLIC MEETING RE: ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT - HOCHSTETLER**  
**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2016**

Mayor Leo Jobin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with Councillors Chris Jull, Walter Ross, and Nunzio Scarfone present. Mayor Leo Jobin explained that the reason for the meeting is to ensure that sufficient information is made available to the public regarding the proposed zoning by-law amendment.

A letter from the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority, dated September 23, 2016, was received, advising that the Conservation Authority reviewed the application, as per its mandate, and has no objection to the application.




Mayor Leo Jobin asked if any members of the public in attendance wished to speak in support of the project. No one spoke in support of the project.
