### Prepare now for winter power outages

Falling leaves will soon bring falling temperatures. Before ice,  
wind, and snowstorms knock out the power and put the chill on  
your home, be ready by tuning up your generator and cleaning  
your wood stove's chimney. It's also a good time to ensure you  
have:

- A good supply of batteries and drinking water, along with battery-powered lamps and flashlights.
- A solar charger for your cell phone.
- Working smoke and carbon monoxide alarms.
- A battery-powered radio, and;
- Your neighbour's phone number. During an extended outage, it's a good time to check on neighbours, and maybe have your own power outage potluck.

## Beat the Silent Killer

Stay safe from carbon monoxide.

Ensure all fuel-burning appliances  
in your home are inspected annually.

Install and regularly test  
carbon monoxide alarms.



You must install a **carbon monoxide alarm** adjacent to all sleeping  
areas if your home has fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an  
attached garage.

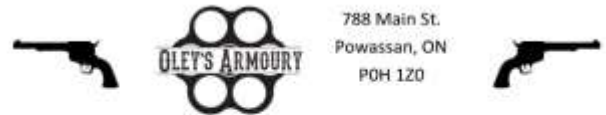
