

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHISHOLM

BY-LAW NO. 2011-40

Being a By-law to decrease the rate of speed of motor vehicles

WHEREAS The Highway Traffic Act R.S.O., 1990, Section 128 (2), Chapter H.8, as amended, provides that the council of a municipality may, for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction, by by-law prescribe a rate of speed different from the rate set out in Section 128 (1) of the Highway Traffic Act;

AND WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O., 1990, Section 128 (3), Chapter H.8 as amended provides that the rate of speed prescribed under Section 128 (2) may be any speed that is not greater than 100 kilometres per hour;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed of motor vehicles on certain highways within the Corporation of the Township of Chisholm be restricted;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chisholm **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. A speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour is hereby established on Alderdale Road, from its intersection with Chiswick Line to its intersection with Memorial Park Drive.

That this by-law shall come into force upon the erection of the required signs.

The penalties provided in subsection (14) of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act, as amended, shall apply to offenses against this By-law.

READ A FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME, AND PASSED THIS 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2011.
