PHRAGMITES FACTS

- Invasive Phragmites is an aggressive plant that spreads quickly and out – competes native species for water and nutrients;
- It releases toxins from its roots into the soil to hinder the growth of and kill surrounding plants; and
- Provides poor habitat and food supplies for wildlife; and
- Proper removal and disposal is crucial.

According to By-law 2010-06, all dog owners must purchase a dog tag for each dog they possess on or before March 31st. **Dog License fees are as follows:**

1 dog	\$10.00	\$30.00
2 dogs	\$25.00	\$45.00
3 dogs	\$50.00	\$70.00

The 2025 Dog Tags have been ordered <u>but are NOT</u> <u>available at this time</u>, but we will post on Facebook and in the February Newsletter once they have been received.

Once available, the dog tags will be available for purchase at the office or you can complete the attached form and mail it in along with payment made payable to the Township of Chisholm.

<u>Please Note:</u> Maximum three (3) dogs per household as per by-law 2010-06.
