#### NOTICE - ROAD CLOSURE

**Please be advised that there will be road closures in June on Memorial Park Drive, as the Public Works will be starting road work between Kells Rd and Alderdale Rd. Notices will be posted on the website and social media.**

#### NOTICE RE: BUDGET

Please take notice that Council passed the 2024 Budget at their regular meeting May 28, 2024. The tax rate is going up a bit to cover the rising costs of almost everything. The 2023 tax rate was .01221473 and the 2024 rate is .01269683.

#### CAPITAL BUDGET

- Fire Department to replace 5 bunker suits, the rescue van and Thermal Imager for a total of \$101,500. Paid for by reserves.
- Public works Freightliner replace conveyor for a total of \$12,000. Paid for by reserves.
- Project on Memorial Park Drive between Alderdale and Kells. In 2024, base repairs (dig outs), pulverizing the hard surfacing and adding gravel. In 2025, re-hard surface. Paid for by Gas Tax and OCIF funding.
- Gravel application: Memorial Park Drive from Kells to Golf Course Road, Beach Road from Memorial to Bayview/Islandview and Hills Siding Road. Also, a gravel lift to low parts of Memorial near Beach Intersection. Paid for by Gas Tax and OCIF funding. (There will be no improvements to Beach Road between Memorial and Chiswick Line)

#### SAFE CAMPFIRES

#### MESSAGE FROM FIRE CHIEF, RAY FORD

You are planning a relaxing campfire, but if an ember from your fire ignites a runaway wildfire, it will ruin your day. Trust us, we have seen it.

Avoid disrupting your marshmallow roast by following the rules in Chisholm's Open-Air Burning By-Law (2022-05). The by-law allows "recreational campfires for cooking and warmth" without a permit, **but only under the following conditions:**

- There is no fire ban or provincial Restricted Fire Zone in effect.

- The fire is **less than** one metre high by one metre wide.
- The fire is contained **on and within non-combustible surfaces**.
- The fire is at least three metres from a forest area, and a **three-metre area around the fire is free of flammable material**.
- The space above the fire is clear of overhanging vegetation by at least three metres.
- The other conditions for permitted fires are burning at least six metres away from dwellings and structures, and **avoiding burning during windy conditions, keeping an eye on the fire**, and having fire-control tools like a shovel and bucket of water or garden hose handy.

### Friendly Reminder – Septic Pump Outs

By-law 2010-34, being a By-Law to regulate the pump out of septic tanks on properties located within 300 meters of Wasi Lake.

As per By-law 2010 -34, It is mandatory that septic tanks on properties located within 300 meters of Wasi Lake gets pumped out once every five (5) years. Please send a copy of the receipt to show proof of pump out to the Township Office.

This By-Law is necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Township of Chisholm, and other municipalities that may be affected, to protect the water supply from any impact from septic systems adjacent to Wasi Lake.

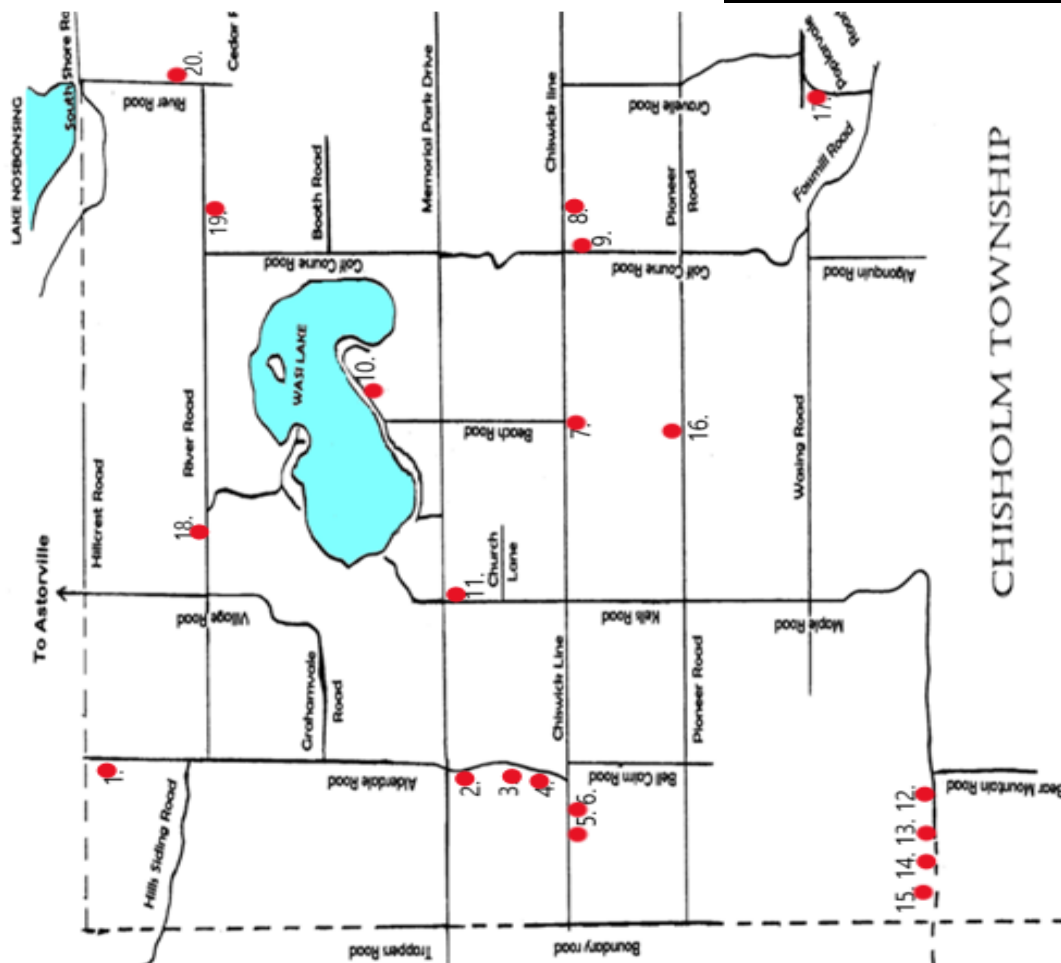
