BURN PERMITS NEW PROCEDURES COMING SOON WITH burnpermit.com

The Township is currently in the process of setting up the process of issuing burn permits online at <u>burnpermit.com</u>. Starting October 2023, burn permits will be required and residents will be able to obtain burn permits both online or in person at the Township Office.

More information can be found on the Township website, Facebook page and will be provided in the October Newsletter. This will be a short trial run for 2023 as permits are only required until October 31, 2023.

We are hoping to work out the kinks of this new system before the start of the next burn permit season starting April 1, 2024.
