Hit the roads safely with a winter car emergency kit!

When the weather outside is frightful but you still have to venture out on the road, make sure you're ready for mishaps by packing these emergency items in your car:

- * Healthy snacks that will not spoil, like energy bars.
- * Water in plastic bottles that will not break if they freeze.
- * A blanket.
- * Extra clothes, boots and mittens – consider warm work clothing in case you have to dig yourself out. (A reflective vest is a good idea, too).
- * First Aid Kit with seatbelt cutter.
- * Spare snow shovel, scraper and snow brush.
- * Candle in a deep can and matches for warmth.
- * Wind-up flashlight.
- * Whistle to call for help.
- * A tow rope, booster cables and reflective warning lights/triangles.

If you are stuck in your car waiting for help, crack open a window on the side of the car that is sheltered from wind. It is best to avoid constant idling, to save fuel. But if you are idling your engine, check that your exhaust pipe is not blocked by snow and ice. In whiteout or blizzard-like conditions, it is safer to shelter in your car and wait for help than to try walking to safety.
